The proposed development will consist of a 10 year permission for a 110kV electrical substation and associated 110kV infrastructure required to connect a solar farm (permitted under Cork County Council Reg. Ref: 23/4564; which amended previous permission Reg. Ref: 17/5370 and ABP-300434-17) to the existing Knockraha 220kV substation.  
The substation compound will include 2 No. single storey control buildings: An EirGrid control building (comprising relay room, battery room, workshop / store, mess room and W.C. and generator room); and, An Independent Power Producer control building (comprising control room, switchgear room, office, store and W.C.); The proposal also includes: 110KV grid transformer and two-house transformers within banded enclosures (height approximately 6m) and associated infrastructure; MV switchgear containers; Lightning protection masts; Perimeter security fencing and entrance gates; Security lighting; Telecommunication dishes; Underground cabling; Site drainage infrastructure; Proposed access from the L6989 to the south; Temporary construction compound; and, All associated development works above and below ground including landscaping. A Natura Impact Statement (NIS) is submitted with this application.
